## Revised Criteria for USDF Youth Volunteer of the Year Award

Lexington, KY (June 12, 2008) - The United States Dressage Federation has issued revised criteria, effective immediately, for youth members nominated for the USDF Youth Volunteer of the Year Award to allow volunteer hours accumulated between September 1 of the previous calendar year and August 31 of the current calendar year to be included in the required number of hours. This is a change from the previous requirement that volunteer hours must have been accumulated in the current membership year.

Nominations for the USDF Youth Volunteer of the Year Award can be made by any current USDF member and must be submitted to USDF by August 31. The winner of this award is selected by the members of the USDF Youth Executive Board and recognized at the Adequan/USDF Annual Convention. In addition to having their name inscribed on the perpetual trophy housed in the Roemer Foundation/USDF Hall of Fame, the winner will receive a "keeper" trophy, a \$500 Youth Convention Scholarship, and be featured in the collector's edition of the *USDF Connection* yearbook.

## USDF Announces Dates for Two 2008 USDF Sport Horse Seminars

Lexington, KY (June 24, 2008) – The United States Dressage Federation announced the dates for two USDF Sport Horse Seminars during 2008. The first seminar will be held July 26-27, 2008 in Fulshear, TX, with Hilda Gurney and sponsored by the Houston Dressage Society. The second seminar will be held October 18-19, 2008 in Colora, MD, with Melissa Creswick and sponsored by Hilltop Farm, Inc. Attendees of these seminars can earn up to four USDF University Program credits.

USDF Sport Horse Seminars are two-day programs designed to educate breeders, riders, trainers and potential sport horse owners about the qualities desired in a sport horse and how to rate these qualities. Other topics covered are the basics of preparing horses to be shown in-hand and competition rules and procedures. Additionally, these seminars serve as prerequisites for individuals applying to become USEF-licensed dressage/sport horse breeding judges.

**Goal:** To encourage adult amateur riders to perform in a rated show atmosphere; to have fun, support each other and meet new friends; and to promote the team concept of amateur competition in a special and unique venue.

**How to Qualify:** Rider needs two scores from two different shows and two different judges from any USDF dressage test of the entered level from October 17, 2007 to September 30, 2008. The score can be received from any competition, schooling or rated, *in any test of the level*. Qualifying scores needed for each level: 61% Training Level, 60% 1<sup>st</sup> Level, 59% 2<sup>nd</sup> Level, 58% 3<sup>rd</sup> Level and above. Rider may compete on a different horse from the one on which the qualifying scores were received. Rider must submit a photo-copy of the front page of the tests with entry form including date, show, test score, judge's name and signature, or submit a copy of their rider score sheet from the USDF website, if the scores were earned at recognized shows. The judge must be at least a USDF "L" Graduate or any recorded USEF/FEI judge.

**Team Competition:** A team of three/four riders will compete in any combination of Levels on the first day of the competition. Team members can compete at any level – it is not required that they all compete at the same level. Riders must ride the highest test of the level with the exception of Training Level Division A, which will ride Training Level Test 2 (see note below). These rides are conducted during the regular show. You will pay an additional entry fee to compete in both the NRADC (pinned separately) and in the regular competition.

**Levels: Note a special Division split for Training Level riders**

- Training Level Division A (Training Level Test 2 – for riders who have never competed at 1<sup>st</sup> level or above. Riders in this division may compete only in this division).
- Training Level Division B (Training Level Test 4 – note that riders may choose to compete in Division B even if they have not competed at 1<sup>st</sup> level or above)

**Scoring:** The lowest score of the team will be dropped. Note: Three persons could ride four horses, meaning one rides two, or teams of three persons riding three horses okay with no dropped score. The three remaining scores (percentage) will be averaged together to form the team percentage score. Awards will be offered for the top three teams based on overall team percentage score.

**Optional:** Schooling show on Friday, non-rated.

Note: If you do not have a team but would like to participate, please send in an individual entry. It will be held until enough individual entries are received to form a team. Your team will then be entered, and you will be notified with contact information. You and your new teammates can then come up with a team name.

**Overall Individual Award Qualifier:** In order to maximize the number of riders eligible to compete in Sunday's freestyle competition, only one judge will be scoring the freestyle test. The top 36 scoring riders from Saturday's team competition

will advance to the freestyle competition on Sunday where they will be required to ride a freestyle test appropriate for their level. In the event a qualified rider chooses to not compete for the individual awards, the next scoring rider will become eligible to compete. Overall individual award placements will be based on the average of the individual test and freestyle test scores, regardless of level/division.

**Awards:** First through sixth place NRADC ribbons will be awarded to NRADC participants for individual class placements in both the freestyle and the regular test. All participants and volunteers will receive a hat and t-shirt with the NRADC logo. For the NRADC overall awards, first place team and individual riders will receive a jacket, second place team and individual riders will receive a cooler, third place team and individual riders will receive a quarter sheet. In addition, ribbons will be awarded to the top ten individual riders and the top three teams.

Training Level Freestyle: Consult website for requirements. All other Freestyle tests to follow USDF/USEF regulations for their level.

### **Show Logistics:**

Opening Date: *First day entry can be postmarked to be accepted.* Closing Date: *Last day entry can be postmarked to be accepted.*

Judges/TD/general rules and information: Please refer to MVHC October Fall Dressage Show. Details in NEDA Omnibus and [www.mysticvalleyhuntclub.com](http://www.mysticvalleyhuntclub.com).

Fees: Each division is \$150 which includes the following: Friday, non-judged schooling ride (optional); Saturday, judged ride; and Sunday, freestyle. In addition, riders who are not USEF or USDF members must pay their non-member fee. All riders must pay the USEF drug fee. (Riders also in open show only pay 1 drug fee per horse.) Stabling is offered. Please refer to Omnibus or website.
